POLICE ASSURE PUBLIC OF ACTION OVER ASSAULTS DURING ABLEKUMA NORTH ELECTIONS

- 1. The Accra Regional Police Command recorded some isolated incidents of violence, including cases of assault resulting in disorder at some polling stations during the Ablekuma North parliamentary re-run held yesterday, Friday, 11th July 2025.
- Preliminary reports indicate that these incidents caused temporary disruptions to the otherwise peaceful conduct of the election in some polling stations. Police officers intervened promptly to restore calm and ensure voting continued without further interruptions.
- 3. The Regional Command is taking steps to identify perpetrators, and anyone found to have engaged in acts of violence, intimidation, or breach of the peace will be arrested and taken through the due process of law.
- 4. The Accra Regional Police Command wishes to encourage anyone with information on the persons involved in these incidents to contact the Police through emergency numbers 18555 or 191 to assist with ongoing investigations.
